

## Alabama: District 1

### The Need for Services

- 41,540 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Alabama's 1st congressional district.

### Meeting the Need

- There are 26 family planning clinics in Alabama's 1st congressional district. 7 are run by health departments, 2 are run by hospitals, 1 is run by Planned Parenthood, 16 are run by community health centers and 0 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 15,940 women, including 4,390 teenagers.\* 29% are served by health departments, 6% are served by hospitals, 2% are served by Planned Parenthood, 62% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

### The Key Role of Title X

- 12 of the family planning clinics in Alabama's 1st congressional district are supported by Title X. 7 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 0 are run by Planned Parenthood, 5 are run by community health centers and 0 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Alabama's 1st congressional district serve 11,170 women, including 3,090 teenagers.\* 42% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 0% are served by Planned Parenthood, 58% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

*\* These women may or may not live in 1st congressional district.*
