

## Alabama: District 4

### The Need for Services

- 32,010 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Alabama's 4th congressional district.

### Meeting the Need

- There are 25 family planning clinics in Alabama's 4th congressional district. 12 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 0 are run by Planned Parenthood, 13 are run by community health centers and 0 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 15,880 women, including 5,010 teenagers.\* 88% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 0% are served by Planned Parenthood, 12% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

### The Key Role of Title X

- 12 of the family planning clinics in Alabama's 4th congressional district are supported by Title X. 12 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 0 are run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 0 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Alabama's 4th congressional district serve 14,050 women, including 4,500 teenagers.\* 100% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 0% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

*\* These women may or may not live in 4th congressional district.*
