

Arizona: District 1

The Need for Services

- 52,460 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Arizona's 1st congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 61 family planning clinics in Arizona's 1st congressional district. 23 are run by health departments, 18 are run by hospitals, 3 are run by Planned Parenthood, 10 are run by community health centers and 7 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 19,340 women, including 5,190 teenagers.* 33% are served by health departments, 31% are served by hospitals, 16% are served by Planned Parenthood, 14% are served by community health centers and 7% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 15 of the family planning clinics in Arizona's 1st congressional district are supported by Title X. 8 are run by health departments, 5 are run by hospitals, 2 are run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 0 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Arizona's 1st congressional district serve 8,060 women, including 1,870 teenagers.* 17% are served by health departments, 57% are served by hospitals, 26% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 1st congressional district.*
