

Arizona: District 2

The Need for Services

- 23,360 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Arizona's 2nd congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 16 family planning clinics in Arizona's 2nd congressional district. 3 are run by health departments, 3 are run by hospitals, 0 are run by Planned Parenthood, 4 are run by community health centers and 6 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 5,120 women, including 950 teenagers.* 14% are served by health departments, 24% are served by hospitals, 0% are served by Planned Parenthood, 36% are served by community health centers and 26% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 1 of the family planning clinics in 2nd congressional district is supported by Title X. 0 are run by health departments, 1 is run by a hospital, 0 are run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 0 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Arizona's 2nd congressional district serve 1,140 women, including 170 teenagers.* 0% are served by health departments, 100% are served by hospitals, 0% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 2nd congressional district.*
