



Arizona: District 4

The Need for Services

- 71,000 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Arizona's 4th congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 19 family planning clinics in Arizona's 4th congressional district. 1 is run by a health department, 9 are run by hospitals, 3 are run by Planned Parenthood, 3 are run by community health centers and 3 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 16,810 women, including 2,570 teenagers.* 14% are served by health departments, 8% are served by hospitals, 42% are served by Planned Parenthood, 19% are served by community health centers and 17% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 4 of the family planning clinics in Arizona's 4th congressional district are supported by Title X. 1 is run by a health department, 0 are run by hospitals, 2 are run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 1 is served by an other type of agency.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Arizona's 4th congressional district serve 8,020 women, including 1,090 teenagers.* 29% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 65% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 6% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 4th congressional district.*
