

Arizona: District 6

The Need for Services

- 21,010 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Arizona's 6th congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 6 family planning clinics in Arizona's 6th congressional district. 1 is run by a health department, 2 are run by hospitals, 2 are run by Planned Parenthood, 1 is run by a community health center and 0 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 4,210 women, including 1,030 teenagers.* 5% are served by health departments, 5% are served by hospitals, 76% are served by Planned Parenthood, 14% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 1 of the family planning clinics in 6th congressional district is supported by Title X. 1 is run by a health department, 0 are run by hospitals, 0 are run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 0 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Arizona's 6th congressional district serve 220 women, including 70 teenagers.* 100% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 0% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 6th congressional district.*
