



Arizona: District 7

The Need for Services

- 62,350 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Arizona's 7th congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 44 family planning clinics in Arizona's 7th congressional district. 8 are run by health departments, 4 are run by hospitals, 5 are run by Planned Parenthood, 18 are run by community health centers and 9 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 24,580 women, including 6,810 teenagers.* 17% are served by health departments, 9% are served by hospitals, 22% are served by Planned Parenthood, 34% are served by community health centers and 18% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 11 of the family planning clinics in Arizona's 7th congressional district are supported by Title X. 6 are run by health departments, 1 is run by a hospital, 4 are run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 0 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Arizona's 7th congressional district serve 9,090 women, including 4,040 teenagers.* 35% are served by health departments, 6% are served by hospitals, 59% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 7th congressional district.*
