

## Arizona: District 8

### The Need for Services

- 30,530 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Arizona's 8th congressional district.

### Meeting the Need

- There are 15 family planning clinics in Arizona's 8th congressional district. 7 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 3 are run by Planned Parenthood, 5 are run by community health centers and 0 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 13,580 women, including 6,130 teenagers.\* 27% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 61% are served by Planned Parenthood, 12% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

### The Key Role of Title X

- 5 of the family planning clinics in Arizona's 8th congressional district are supported by Title X. 2 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 3 are run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 0 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Arizona's 8th congressional district serve 11,300 women, including 5,730 teenagers.\* 27% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 73% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

*\* These women may or may not live in 8th congressional district.*
