

Arkansas: District 1

The Need for Services

- 46,700 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Arkansas's 1st congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 54 family planning clinics in Arkansas's 1st congressional district. 36 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 0 are run by Planned Parenthood, 18 are run by community health centers and 0 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 25,880 women, including 8,300 teenagers.* 83% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 0% are served by Planned Parenthood, 17% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 36 of the family planning clinics in Arkansas's 1st congressional district are supported by Title X. 36 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 0 are run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 0 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Arkansas's 1st congressional district serve 21,440 women, including 6,390 teenagers.* 100% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 0% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 1st congressional district.*
