

## Arkansas: District 4

### The Need for Services

- 45,920 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Arkansas's 4th congressional district.

### Meeting the Need

- There are 47 family planning clinics in Arkansas's 4th congressional district. 33 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 0 are run by Planned Parenthood, 14 are run by community health centers and 0 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 24,810 women, including 6,910 teenagers.\* 95% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 0% are served by Planned Parenthood, 5% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

### The Key Role of Title X

- 33 of the family planning clinics in Arkansas's 4th congressional district are supported by Title X. 33 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 0 are run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 0 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Arkansas's 4th congressional district serve 23,600 women, including 6,780 teenagers.\* 100% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 0% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

*\* These women may or may not live in 4th congressional district.*
