



## California: District 1

### The Need for Services

- 47,260 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in California's 1st congressional district.

### Meeting the Need

- There are 56 family planning clinics in California's 1st congressional district. 5 are run by health departments, 13 are run by hospitals, 3 are run by Planned Parenthood, 7 are run by community health centers and 28 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 30,270 women, including 9,290 teenagers.\* 15% are served by health departments, 14% are served by hospitals, 34% are served by Planned Parenthood, 8% are served by community health centers and 30% are served by other types of agencies.

### The Key Role of Title X

- 9 of the family planning clinics in California's 1st congressional district are supported by Title X. 2 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 3 are run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 4 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in California's 1st congressional district serve 16,590 women, including 5,020 teenagers.\* 15% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 62% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 24% are served by other types of agencies.

*\* These women may or may not live in 1st congressional district.*
