



## California: District 11

### The Need for Services

- 24,390 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in California's 11th congressional district.

### Meeting the Need

- There are 11 family planning clinics in California's 11th congressional district. 1 is run by a health department, 1 is run by a hospital, 4 are run by Planned Parenthood, 2 are run by community health centers and 3 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 19,460 women, including 6,070 teenagers.\* 5% are served by health departments, 2% are served by hospitals, 68% are served by Planned Parenthood, 6% are served by community health centers and 19% are served by other types of agencies.

### The Key Role of Title X

- 6 of the family planning clinics in California's 11th congressional district are supported by Title X. 0 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 3 are run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 3 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in California's 11th congressional district serve 15,050 women, including 4,760 teenagers.\* 0% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 75% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 25% are served by other types of agencies.

*\* These women may or may not live in 11th congressional district.*
