

California: District 13

The Need for Services

- 19,770 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in California's 13th congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 8 family planning clinics in California's 13th congressional district. 3 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 1 is run by Planned Parenthood, 2 are run by community health centers and 2 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 11,880 women, including 4,180 teenagers.* 10% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 46% are served by Planned Parenthood, 7% are served by community health centers and 37% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 2 of the family planning clinics in California's 13th congressional district are supported by Title X. 0 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 1 is run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 1 is served by an other type of agency.
- These Title X-supported clinics in California's 13th congressional district serve 9,430 women, including 3,180 teenagers.* 0% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 57% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 43% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 13th congressional district.*
