

California: District 14

The Need for Services

- 18,080 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in California's 14th congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 12 family planning clinics in California's 14th congressional district. 6 are run by health departments, 1 is run by a hospital, 3 are run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 2 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 25,610 women, including 5,920 teenagers.* 23% are served by health departments, 2% are served by hospitals, 71% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 4% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 5 of the family planning clinics in California's 14th congressional district are supported by Title X. 0 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 3 are run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 2 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in California's 14th congressional district serve 19,270 women, including 3,690 teenagers.* 0% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 95% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 5% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 14th congressional district.*
