

## California: District 16

### The Need for Services

- 28,060 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in California's 16th congressional district.

### Meeting the Need

- There are 11 family planning clinics in California's 16th congressional district. 0 are run by health departments, 3 are run by hospitals, 4 are run by Planned Parenthood, 3 are run by community health centers and 1 is run by an other type of agency.
- Together, these clinics serve 32,140 women, including 8,070 teenagers.\* 0% are served by health departments, 10% are served by hospitals, 78% are served by Planned Parenthood, 7% are served by community health centers and 4% are served by other types of agencies.

### The Key Role of Title X

- 5 of the family planning clinics in California's 16th congressional district are supported by Title X. 0 are run by health departments, 1 is run by a hospital, 3 are run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 1 is served by an other type of agency.
- These Title X-supported clinics in California's 16th congressional district serve 27,470 women, including 7,320 teenagers.\* 0% are served by health departments, 6% are served by hospitals, 89% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 5% are served by other types of agencies.

*\* These women may or may not live in 16th congressional district.*
