

California: District 17

The Need for Services

- 38,370 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in California's 17th congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 27 family planning clinics in California's 17th congressional district. 6 are run by health departments, 2 are run by hospitals, 7 are run by Planned Parenthood, 7 are run by community health centers and 5 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 41,140 women, including 8,820 teenagers.* 8% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 77% are served by Planned Parenthood, 10% are served by community health centers and 5% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 6 of the family planning clinics in California's 17th congressional district are supported by Title X. 0 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 6 are run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 0 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in California's 17th congressional district serve 27,740 women, including 6,440 teenagers.* 0% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 100% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 17th congressional district.*
