

## California: District 18

### The Need for Services

- 61,000 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in California's 18th congressional district.

### Meeting the Need

- There are 35 family planning clinics in California's 18th congressional district. 5 are run by health departments, 8 are run by hospitals, 2 are run by Planned Parenthood, 13 are run by community health centers and 7 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 33,560 women, including 7,850 teenagers.\* 24% are served by health departments, 5% are served by hospitals, 37% are served by Planned Parenthood, 18% are served by community health centers and 16% are served by other types of agencies.

### The Key Role of Title X

- 9 of the family planning clinics in California's 18th congressional district are supported by Title X. 5 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 2 are run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 2 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in California's 18th congressional district serve 23,970 women, including 6,510 teenagers.\* 34% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 51% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 15% are served by other types of agencies.

*\* These women may or may not live in 18th congressional district.*
