

California: District 19

The Need for Services

- 40,560 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in California's 19th congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 19 family planning clinics in California's 19th congressional district. 4 are run by health departments, 3 are run by hospitals, 3 are run by Planned Parenthood, 4 are run by community health centers and 5 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 28,010 women, including 8,340 teenagers.* 15% are served by health departments, 1% are served by hospitals, 72% are served by Planned Parenthood, 8% are served by community health centers and 4% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 5 of the family planning clinics in California's 19th congressional district are supported by Title X. 2 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 3 are run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 0 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in California's 19th congressional district serve 23,590 women, including 7,330 teenagers.* 14% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 86% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 19th congressional district.*
