

## California: District 2

### The Need for Services

- 48,080 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in California's 2nd congressional district.

### Meeting the Need

- There are 47 family planning clinics in California's 2nd congressional district. 8 are run by health departments, 3 are run by hospitals, 4 are run by Planned Parenthood, 11 are run by community health centers and 21 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 33,690 women, including 11,780 teenagers.\* 19% are served by health departments, 3% are served by hospitals, 27% are served by Planned Parenthood, 13% are served by community health centers and 38% are served by other types of agencies.

### The Key Role of Title X

- 7 of the family planning clinics in California's 2nd congressional district are supported by Title X. 2 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 3 are run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 2 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in California's 2nd congressional district serve 14,860 women, including 4,810 teenagers.\* 14% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 35% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 51% are served by other types of agencies.

*\* These women may or may not live in 2nd congressional district.*
