

## California: District 20

### The Need for Services

- 78,800 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in California's 20th congressional district.

### Meeting the Need

- There are 48 family planning clinics in California's 20th congressional district. 11 are run by health departments, 10 are run by hospitals, 1 is run by Planned Parenthood, 20 are run by community health centers and 6 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 49,570 women, including 13,290 teenagers.\* 18% are served by health departments, 16% are served by hospitals, 19% are served by Planned Parenthood, 36% are served by community health centers and 11% are served by other types of agencies.

### The Key Role of Title X

- 10 of the family planning clinics in California's 20th congressional district are supported by Title X. 5 are run by health departments, 3 are run by hospitals, 1 is run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 1 is served by an other type of agency.
- These Title X-supported clinics in California's 20th congressional district serve 26,290 women, including 5,490 teenagers.\* 26% are served by health departments, 27% are served by hospitals, 35% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 11% are served by other types of agencies.

*\* These women may or may not live in 20th congressional district.*
