

California: District 22

The Need for Services

- 36,040 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in California's 22th congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 20 family planning clinics in California's 22th congressional district. 4 are run by health departments, 3 are run by hospitals, 1 is run by Planned Parenthood, 7 are run by community health centers and 5 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 19,430 women, including 6,520 teenagers.* 4% are served by health departments, 10% are served by hospitals, 55% are served by Planned Parenthood, 14% are served by community health centers and 17% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 2 of the family planning clinics in California's 22th congressional district are supported by Title X. 0 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 1 is run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 1 is served by an other type of agency.
- These Title X-supported clinics in California's 22th congressional district serve 11,490 women, including 3,980 teenagers.* 0% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 92% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 8% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 22th congressional district.*
