

California: District 23

The Need for Services

- 48,580 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in California's 23th congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 26 family planning clinics in California's 23th congressional district. 10 are run by health departments, 1 is run by a hospital, 3 are run by Planned Parenthood, 5 are run by community health centers and 7 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 46,260 women, including 7,880 teenagers.* 43% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 28% are served by Planned Parenthood, 7% are served by community health centers and 21% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 4 of the family planning clinics in California's 23th congressional district are supported by Title X. 0 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 2 are run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 2 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in California's 23th congressional district serve 14,940 women, including 3,270 teenagers.* 0% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 74% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 26% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 23th congressional district.*
