

California: District 24

The Need for Services

- 19,560 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in California's 24th congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 11 family planning clinics in California's 24th congressional district. 4 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 1 is run by Planned Parenthood, 5 are run by community health centers and 1 is run by an other type of agency.
- Together, these clinics serve 9,260 women, including 1,560 teenagers.* 29% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 47% are served by Planned Parenthood, 23% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 1 of the family planning clinics in 24th congressional district is supported by Title X. 0 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 1 is run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 0 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in California's 24th congressional district serve 4,360 women, including 780 teenagers.* 0% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 100% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 24th congressional district.*
