

California: District 25

The Need for Services

- 34,110 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in California's 25th congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 13 family planning clinics in California's 25th congressional district. 4 are run by health departments, 3 are run by hospitals, 0 are run by Planned Parenthood, 2 are run by community health centers and 4 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 6,280 women, including 1,250 teenagers.* 47% are served by health departments, 9% are served by hospitals, 0% are served by Planned Parenthood, 22% are served by community health centers and 21% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 4 of the family planning clinics in California's 25th congressional district are supported by Title X. 2 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 0 are run by Planned Parenthood, 1 is run by a community health center and 1 is served by an other type of agency.
- These Title X-supported clinics in California's 25th congressional district serve 4,730 women, including 850 teenagers.* 54% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 0% are served by Planned Parenthood, 28% are served by community health centers and 18% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 25th congressional district.*
