



## California: District 26

### The Need for Services

- 23,210 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in California's 26th congressional district.

### Meeting the Need

- There are 3 family planning clinics in California's 26th congressional district. 1 is run by a health department, 1 is run by a hospital, 1 is run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 0 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 4,460 women, including 1,300 teenagers.\* 3% are served by health departments, 7% are served by hospitals, 90% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

### The Key Role of Title X

- 2 of the family planning clinics in California's 26th congressional district are supported by Title X. 1 is run by a health department, 0 are run by hospitals, 1 is run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 0 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in California's 26th congressional district serve 4,130 women, including 1,200 teenagers.\* 3% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 97% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

*\* These women may or may not live in 26th congressional district.*
