

California: District 27

The Need for Services

- 38,640 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in California's 27th congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 9 family planning clinics in California's 27th congressional district. 3 are run by health departments, 3 are run by hospitals, 1 is run by Planned Parenthood, 1 is run by a community health center and 1 is run by an other type of agency.
- Together, these clinics serve 10,320 women, including 1,840 teenagers.* 7% are served by health departments, 28% are served by hospitals, 50% are served by Planned Parenthood, 12% are served by community health centers and 3% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 4 of the family planning clinics in California's 27th congressional district are supported by Title X. 2 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 1 is run by Planned Parenthood, 1 is run by a community health center and 0 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in California's 27th congressional district serve 6,980 women, including 1,490 teenagers.* 9% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 74% are served by Planned Parenthood, 18% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 27th congressional district.*
