

California: District 28

The Need for Services

- 54,090 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in California's 28th congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 13 family planning clinics in California's 28th congressional district. 4 are run by health departments, 1 is run by a hospital, 1 is run by Planned Parenthood, 3 are run by community health centers and 4 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 19,750 women, including 2,850 teenagers.* 26% are served by health departments, 1% are served by hospitals, 18% are served by Planned Parenthood, 26% are served by community health centers and 30% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 9 of the family planning clinics in California's 28th congressional district are supported by Title X. 4 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 1 is run by Planned Parenthood, 2 are run by community health centers and 2 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in California's 28th congressional district serve 19,120 women, including 2,800 teenagers.* 27% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 19% are served by Planned Parenthood, 27% are served by community health centers and 28% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 28th congressional district.*
