

California: District 29

The Need for Services

- 40,680 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in California's 29th congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 8 family planning clinics in California's 29th congressional district. 3 are run by health departments, 1 is run by a hospital, 3 are run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 1 is run by an other type of agency.
- Together, these clinics serve 14,240 women, including 2,590 teenagers.* 12% are served by health departments, 5% are served by hospitals, 82% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 1% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 6 of the family planning clinics in California's 29th congressional district are supported by Title X. 3 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 3 are run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 0 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in California's 29th congressional district serve 13,390 women, including 2,520 teenagers.* 13% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 87% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 29th congressional district.*
