



California: District 30

The Need for Services

- 28,720 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in California's 30th congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 8 family planning clinics in California's 30th congressional district. 0 are run by health departments, 3 are run by hospitals, 1 is run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 4 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 29,430 women, including 2,920 teenagers.* 0% are served by health departments, 27% are served by hospitals, 30% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 43% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 6 of the family planning clinics in California's 30th congressional district are supported by Title X. 0 are run by health departments, 1 is run by a hospital, 1 is run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 4 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in California's 30th congressional district serve 21,890 women, including 2,290 teenagers.* 0% are served by health departments, 2% are served by hospitals, 40% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 58% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 30th congressional district.*
