

California: District 31

The Need for Services

- 84,140 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in California's 31th congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 15 family planning clinics in California's 31th congressional district. 1 is run by a health department, 1 is run by a hospital, 1 is run by Planned Parenthood, 4 are run by community health centers and 8 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 16,380 women, including 1,790 teenagers.* 21% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 38% are served by Planned Parenthood, 4% are served by community health centers and 36% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 4 of the family planning clinics in California's 31th congressional district are supported by Title X. 1 is run by a health department, 0 are run by hospitals, 1 is run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 2 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in California's 31th congressional district serve 12,300 women, including 1,130 teenagers.* 28% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 51% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 21% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 31th congressional district.*
