

## California: District 32

### The Need for Services

- 51,350 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in California's 32th congressional district.

### Meeting the Need

- There are 10 family planning clinics in California's 32th congressional district. 3 are run by health departments, 3 are run by hospitals, 1 is run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 3 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 12,430 women, including 2,460 teenagers.\* 33% are served by health departments, 6% are served by hospitals, 27% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 34% are served by other types of agencies.

### The Key Role of Title X

- 5 of the family planning clinics in California's 32th congressional district are supported by Title X. 3 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 1 is run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 1 is served by an other type of agency.
- These Title X-supported clinics in California's 32th congressional district serve 11,060 women, including 2,370 teenagers.\* 37% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 31% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 32% are served by other types of agencies.

*\* These women may or may not live in 32th congressional district.*
