

California: District 33

The Need for Services

- 67,290 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in California's 33th congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 8 family planning clinics in California's 33th congressional district. 0 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 0 are run by Planned Parenthood, 3 are run by community health centers and 5 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 4,400 women, including 750 teenagers.* 0% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 0% are served by Planned Parenthood, 39% are served by community health centers and 61% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 3 of the family planning clinics in California's 33th congressional district are supported by Title X. 0 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 0 are run by Planned Parenthood, 2 are run by community health centers and 1 is served by an other type of agency.
- These Title X-supported clinics in California's 33th congressional district serve 2,160 women, including 470 teenagers.* 0% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 0% are served by Planned Parenthood, 63% are served by community health centers and 37% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 33th congressional district.*
