

California: District 34

The Need for Services

- 67,860 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in California's 34th congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 27 family planning clinics in California's 34th congressional district. 5 are run by health departments, 5 are run by hospitals, 2 are run by Planned Parenthood, 6 are run by community health centers and 9 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 20,740 women, including 2,090 teenagers.* 28% are served by health departments, 16% are served by hospitals, 9% are served by Planned Parenthood, 9% are served by community health centers and 38% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 10 of the family planning clinics in California's 34th congressional district are supported by Title X. 4 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 2 are run by Planned Parenthood, 1 is run by a community health center and 3 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in California's 34th congressional district serve 14,960 women, including 1,430 teenagers.* 37% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 13% are served by Planned Parenthood, 8% are served by community health centers and 42% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 34th congressional district.*
