



## California: District 35

### The Need for Services

- 74,000 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in California's 35th congressional district.

### Meeting the Need

- There are 12 family planning clinics in California's 35th congressional district. 4 are run by health departments, 1 is run by a hospital, 1 is run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 6 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 14,970 women, including 2,790 teenagers.\* 30% are served by health departments, 1% are served by hospitals, 23% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 46% are served by other types of agencies.

### The Key Role of Title X

- 8 of the family planning clinics in California's 35th congressional district are supported by Title X. 4 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 1 is run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 3 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in California's 35th congressional district serve 13,240 women, including 2,550 teenagers.\* 34% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 26% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 40% are served by other types of agencies.

*\* These women may or may not live in 35th congressional district.*
