

California: District 37

The Need for Services

- 70,880 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in California's 37th congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 13 family planning clinics in California's 37th congressional district. 2 are run by health departments, 6 are run by hospitals, 0 are run by Planned Parenthood, 1 is run by a community health center and 4 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 17,400 women, including 2,190 teenagers.* 5% are served by health departments, 78% are served by hospitals, 0% are served by Planned Parenthood, 2% are served by community health centers and 15% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 3 of the family planning clinics in California's 37th congressional district are supported by Title X. 2 are run by health departments, 1 is run by a hospital, 0 are run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 0 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in California's 37th congressional district serve 3,100 women, including 300 teenagers.* 30% are served by health departments, 70% are served by hospitals, 0% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 37th congressional district.*
