



California: District 4

The Need for Services

- 22,700 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in California's 4th congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 33 family planning clinics in California's 4th congressional district. 12 are run by health departments, 6 are run by hospitals, 1 is run by Planned Parenthood, 5 are run by community health centers and 9 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 27,050 women, including 11,160 teenagers.* 57% are served by health departments, 5% are served by hospitals, 33% are served by Planned Parenthood, 3% are served by community health centers and 2% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 10 of the family planning clinics in California's 4th congressional district are supported by Title X. 8 are run by health departments, 1 is run by a hospital, 1 is run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 0 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in California's 4th congressional district serve 17,060 women, including 5,910 teenagers.* 46% are served by health departments, 2% are served by hospitals, 52% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 4th congressional district.*
