

California: District 5

The Need for Services

- 53,740 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in California's 5th congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 14 family planning clinics in California's 5th congressional district. 7 are run by health departments, 1 is run by a hospital, 4 are run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 2 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 33,260 women, including 9,760 teenagers.* 9% are served by health departments, 2% are served by hospitals, 80% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 8% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 4 of the family planning clinics in California's 5th congressional district are supported by Title X. 0 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 4 are run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 0 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in California's 5th congressional district serve 26,610 women, including 7,970 teenagers.* 0% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 100% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 5th congressional district.*
