

## California: District 6

### The Need for Services

- 22,050 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in California's 6th congressional district.

### Meeting the Need

- There are 16 family planning clinics in California's 6th congressional district. 1 is run by a health department, 1 is run by a hospital, 2 are run by Planned Parenthood, 3 are run by community health centers and 9 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 24,120 women, including 7,070 teenagers.\* 16% are served by health departments, 3% are served by hospitals, 44% are served by Planned Parenthood, 2% are served by community health centers and 35% are served by other types of agencies.

### The Key Role of Title X

- 8 of the family planning clinics in California's 6th congressional district are supported by Title X. 1 is run by a health department, 0 are run by hospitals, 2 are run by Planned Parenthood, 3 are run by community health centers and 2 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in California's 6th congressional district serve 16,820 women, including 4,450 teenagers.\* 23% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 64% are served by Planned Parenthood, 3% are served by community health centers and 11% are served by other types of agencies.

*\* These women may or may not live in 6th congressional district.*
