

## California: District 7

### The Need for Services

- 28,250 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in California's 7th congressional district.

### Meeting the Need

- There are 17 family planning clinics in California's 7th congressional district. 8 are run by health departments, 1 is run by a hospital, 5 are run by Planned Parenthood, 2 are run by community health centers and 1 is run by an other type of agency.
- Together, these clinics serve 29,060 women, including 7,970 teenagers.\* 58% are served by health departments, 1% are served by hospitals, 38% are served by Planned Parenthood, 3% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

### The Key Role of Title X

- 1 of the family planning clinics in 7th congressional district is supported by Title X. 0 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 0 are run by Planned Parenthood, 1 is run by a community health center and 0 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in California's 7th congressional district serve 30 women, including 10 teenagers.\* 0% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 0% are served by Planned Parenthood, 100% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

*\* These women may or may not live in 7th congressional district.*
