



## California: District 8

### The Need for Services

- 32,570 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in California's 8th congressional district.

### Meeting the Need

- There are 29 family planning clinics in California's 8th congressional district. 12 are run by health departments, 3 are run by hospitals, 4 are run by Planned Parenthood, 5 are run by community health centers and 5 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 31,020 women, including 4,860 teenagers.\* 34% are served by health departments, 14% are served by hospitals, 29% are served by Planned Parenthood, 10% are served by community health centers and 12% are served by other types of agencies.

### The Key Role of Title X

- 11 of the family planning clinics in California's 8th congressional district are supported by Title X. 9 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 1 is run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 1 is served by an other type of agency.
- These Title X-supported clinics in California's 8th congressional district serve 19,690 women, including 3,660 teenagers.\* 52% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 38% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 10% are served by other types of agencies.

*\* These women may or may not live in 8th congressional district.*
