

California: District 9

The Need for Services

- 50,440 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in California's 9th congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 20 family planning clinics in California's 9th congressional district. 6 are run by health departments, 2 are run by hospitals, 2 are run by Planned Parenthood, 8 are run by community health centers and 2 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 21,460 women, including 6,340 teenagers.* 21% are served by health departments, 11% are served by hospitals, 50% are served by Planned Parenthood, 17% are served by community health centers and 2% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 7 of the family planning clinics in California's 9th congressional district are supported by Title X. 2 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 2 are run by Planned Parenthood, 3 are run by community health centers and 0 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in California's 9th congressional district serve 14,350 women, including 4,070 teenagers.* 15% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 74% are served by Planned Parenthood, 11% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 9th congressional district.*
