

Colorado: District 2

The Need for Services

- 30,230 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Colorado's 2nd congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 12 family planning clinics in Colorado's 2nd congressional district. 2 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 3 are run by Planned Parenthood, 6 are run by community health centers and 1 is run by an other type of agency.
- Together, these clinics serve 14,250 women, including 3,180 teenagers.* 26% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 50% are served by Planned Parenthood, 8% are served by community health centers and 16% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 5 of the family planning clinics in Colorado's 2nd congressional district are supported by Title X. 2 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 2 are run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 1 is served by an other type of agency.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Colorado's 2nd congressional district serve 6,880 women, including 2,100 teenagers.* 54% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 13% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 33% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 2nd congressional district.*
