

Colorado: District 3

The Need for Services

- 41,820 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Colorado's 3rd congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 49 family planning clinics in Colorado's 3rd congressional district. 13 are run by health departments, 3 are run by hospitals, 9 are run by Planned Parenthood, 18 are run by community health centers and 6 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 24,480 women, including 6,200 teenagers.* 35% are served by health departments, 2% are served by hospitals, 41% are served by Planned Parenthood, 14% are served by community health centers and 8% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 27 of the family planning clinics in Colorado's 3rd congressional district are supported by Title X. 13 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 7 are run by Planned Parenthood, 5 are run by community health centers and 2 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Colorado's 3rd congressional district serve 18,280 women, including 4,830 teenagers.* 47% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 38% are served by Planned Parenthood, 7% are served by community health centers and 7% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 3rd congressional district.*
