

Colorado: District 4

The Need for Services

- 41,350 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Colorado's 4th congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 26 family planning clinics in Colorado's 4th congressional district. 13 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 4 are run by Planned Parenthood, 8 are run by community health centers and 1 is run by an other type of agency.
- Together, these clinics serve 20,040 women, including 4,460 teenagers.* 32% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 52% are served by Planned Parenthood, 16% are served by community health centers and 1% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 16 of the family planning clinics in Colorado's 4th congressional district are supported by Title X. 13 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 2 are run by Planned Parenthood, 1 is run by a community health center and 0 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Colorado's 4th congressional district serve 10,650 women, including 2,550 teenagers.* 59% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 29% are served by Planned Parenthood, 12% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 4th congressional district.*
