

## Colorado: District 5

### The Need for Services

- 29,210 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Colorado's 5th congressional district.

### Meeting the Need

- There are 15 family planning clinics in Colorado's 5th congressional district. 4 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 5 are run by Planned Parenthood, 5 are run by community health centers and 1 is run by an other type of agency.
- Together, these clinics serve 12,440 women, including 2,680 teenagers.\* 26% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 62% are served by Planned Parenthood, 11% are served by community health centers and 1% are served by other types of agencies.

### The Key Role of Title X

- 7 of the family planning clinics in Colorado's 5th congressional district are supported by Title X. 4 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 2 are run by Planned Parenthood, 1 is run by a community health center and 0 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Colorado's 5th congressional district serve 5,820 women, including 1,360 teenagers.\* 56% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 42% are served by Planned Parenthood, 2% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

*\* These women may or may not live in 5th congressional district.*
