

Connecticut: District 1

The Need for Services

- 39,310 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Connecticut's 1st congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 11 family planning clinics in Connecticut's 1st congressional district. 0 are run by health departments, 4 are run by hospitals, 5 are run by Planned Parenthood, 2 are run by community health centers and 0 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 17,790 women, including 5,420 teenagers.* 0% are served by health departments, 32% are served by hospitals, 64% are served by Planned Parenthood, 4% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 5 of the family planning clinics in Connecticut's 1st congressional district are supported by Title X. 0 are run by health departments, 1 is run by a hospital, 4 are run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 0 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Connecticut's 1st congressional district serve 11,990 women, including 3,690 teenagers.* 0% are served by health departments, 36% are served by hospitals, 64% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 1st congressional district.*
