

Connecticut: District 2

The Need for Services

- 23,780 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Connecticut's 2nd congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 13 family planning clinics in Connecticut's 2nd congressional district. 0 are run by health departments, 1 is run by a hospital, 6 are run by Planned Parenthood, 6 are run by community health centers and 0 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 14,130 women, including 4,930 teenagers.* 0% are served by health departments, 4% are served by hospitals, 93% are served by Planned Parenthood, 2% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 5 of the family planning clinics in Connecticut's 2nd congressional district are supported by Title X. 0 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 5 are run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 0 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Connecticut's 2nd congressional district serve 10,030 women, including 3,760 teenagers.* 0% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 100% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 2nd congressional district.*
