

## Connecticut: District 3

### The Need for Services

- 37,370 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Connecticut's 3rd congressional district.

### Meeting the Need

- There are 7 family planning clinics in Connecticut's 3rd congressional district. 0 are run by health departments, 1 is run by a hospital, 1 is run by Planned Parenthood, 5 are run by community health centers and 0 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 12,040 women, including 3,800 teenagers.\* 0% are served by health departments, 13% are served by hospitals, 33% are served by Planned Parenthood, 54% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

### The Key Role of Title X

- 3 of the family planning clinics in Connecticut's 3rd congressional district are supported by Title X. 0 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 1 is run by Planned Parenthood, 2 are run by community health centers and 0 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Connecticut's 3rd congressional district serve 8,700 women, including 2,310 teenagers.\* 0% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 46% are served by Planned Parenthood, 54% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

*\* These women may or may not live in 3rd congressional district.*
