

Connecticut: District 4

The Need for Services

- 30,050 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Connecticut's 4th congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 17 family planning clinics in Connecticut's 4th congressional district. 0 are run by health departments, 5 are run by hospitals, 4 are run by Planned Parenthood, 8 are run by community health centers and 0 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 15,790 women, including 5,540 teenagers.* 0% are served by health departments, 31% are served by hospitals, 64% are served by Planned Parenthood, 5% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 3 of the family planning clinics in Connecticut's 4th congressional district are supported by Title X. 0 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 3 are run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 0 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Connecticut's 4th congressional district serve 7,120 women, including 2,360 teenagers.* 0% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 100% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 4th congressional district.*
