

Delaware: at-large

The Need for Services

- 39,760 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Delaware's at-large congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 20 family planning clinics in Delaware's at-large congressional district. 8 are run by health departments, 1 is run by a hospital, 5 are run by Planned Parenthood, 1 is run by a community health center and 5 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 20,600 women, including 6,570 teenagers.* 55% are served by health departments, 5% are served by hospitals, 35% are served by Planned Parenthood, 1% are served by community health centers and 3% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 20 of the family planning clinics in Delaware's at-large congressional district are supported by Title X. 8 are run by health departments, 1 is run by a hospital, 5 are run by Planned Parenthood, 1 is run by a community health center and 5 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Delaware's at-large congressional district serve 20,600 women, including 6,570 teenagers.* 55% are served by health departments, 5% are served by hospitals, 35% are served by Planned Parenthood, 1% are served by community health centers and 3% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in at-large congressional district.*
